Verden Auction Online in November: Riding horses and two-year-old youngster

Verden. No sooner have the stallions from the dressage stallion licensing left Verden than the riding horses for the Verden Auction Online in November have arrived at the Niedersachsenhalle. The collection of 41 riding horses is suitable for all saddles. Competition riders as well as ambitious leisure riders will find the right four-legged partner with whom they can start riding straight away. The collection is completed by 16 selected two-year-old stallions. The final bidding will start on Saturday, 18 November, at 2 pm CET. The virtual bidding for the youngsters will start at 4.30 pm. The first bids can be submitted online from Sunday, 12 November.

The collection includes 31 horses with dressage pedigrees and ten with show jumping pedigrees. "There are many horses that are also suitable for riders who don't want to compete at shows," says Anna Baden, customer advisor for the Hannoveraner Verband. She and the entire team at the training and sales centre are on hand with help and advice to find the perfect match for every rider. Exactly one year ago, it was Olympic champion Andreas Dibowski who purchased the Diarado/Silvio daughter Diadina. Nine months later, he won with the dark bay the Hannoveraner Championships of young cross-country horses and was one of the most impressive six-year-olds at the Bundeschampionat. This put them on the cover of the auction brochure.

online.com. The opening presentation will take place on Saturday, November 11, from 10 a.m. CET in the Niedersachsenhalle in Verden. Just like the free jumping of selected riding horses on Wednesday, November 15, it will be broadcast via livestream on the internet from 10 a.m. The final bidding will begin on Saturday, November 18, at 2 pm CET.

The collection of the Verden auction in November will be completed by 16 two-year-old youngsters, which will also be auctioned online. Current dressage genes and highly interesting jumping genes – both can be found in the pedigrees of the 2021 crop. The final bidding for the youngsters will take place on Saturday, November 18, from 4.30 pm CET at www.verdener-auktion-online.com.
